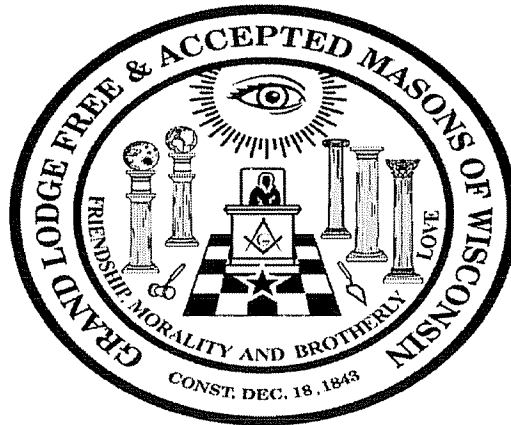

MASONIC CODE OF WISCONSIN

LAWS OF THE GRAND LODGE

Chapter 26 - Grand Lecturer

26.01 Shall Visit and Instruct Lodges. *Each lodge in this Grand Jurisdiction shall be instructed at least annually by the Grand Lecturer or District Lecturer unless the Grand Master shall otherwise order. The Grand Master may, in his discretion, order additional instruction in any lodge upon such terms as he may deem proper; lodges desiring additional instruction may obtain it by arrangement with their District Lecturer.*

The schools are for the elected and appointed officers and will be on the following parts of the cipher:

Open in MM degree and do the purge and take up the pass in that degree.
Present the Flag of the United States of America and introduce the Grand Master/Grand Lodge Officers and admission of a member after the lodge is open.
Receiving a petition and then going over the balloting section. Review the first section of all 3 degrees. Close in MM to open in E.A. degree, close in EA degree and open in FC then retire the Flag of the United States of America and then close in FC. Go over the proper due guards and signs of all degrees, and explain the proper rod and floor work for Stewards and Deacons.
